

Pattern Collection: Accessories P

SIZES One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Body Length: 50" Width at Widest point: 33½"

MATERIALS

Fibra Natura Flax (100% linen;
50g/137 yds)
19 Lily Pad – 8 hanks
Hook: US Size D-3 (3.25 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE 24 sts x 11 rows = 4" in Shawl Body pattern Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

This shawl begins at the tip of the main Shawl Body. The Shawl Body increases into a triangle. The border is worked along the long straight edge and the top short edge of the Shawl Body.

SHAWL BODY

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2, sc in second ch from hook, turn. Row 2 (WS): Ch 5, tr in sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 5, sc in tr, ch 2, 2 dc in ch-5 sp, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in next dc, ch 3, 2 hdc in ch-5 sp, turn.

Row 5: Ch 5, sc in same hdc, ch 2, 3 dc in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-2 sp, turn.

Row 6: Ch 5, hdc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, hdc in next dc, ch 3, 2 hdc in ch-5 sp, turn.

Row 7: Ch 5, sc in same hdc, ch 2, 3 dc in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp, ch 2, 2 dc in ch-5 sp, turn.

Row 8: Ch 2, hdc in next dc, ch 3, hdc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, hdc in next dc, ch 3, 2 hdc in ch-5 sp, turn.

Begin Pattern Repeat

Row 9: Ch 5, sc in same hdc, ch 2, 3 dc in ch-3 sp, [ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in ch-3 sp] to last hdc, ch 2, sc in ch-2 sp, turn -2 3-dc groups. **Row 10:** Ch 5, [hdc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, hdc in next dc, ch 3] to last ch-5 sp, 2 hdc in ch-5 sp, turn.

Row 11: Ch 5, sc in same hdc, [3 dc in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp, ch 2] to last ch-5 sp, 2 dc in ch-5 sp, turn $-2\frac{1}{2}$ 3-dc groups.

Row 12: Ch 2, hdc in next dc, [ch 3, hdc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, hdc in next dc] to last ch-5 sp, ch 3, 2 hdc in ch-5 sp, turn.

Rows 13-132: Rep Rows 9-12, 30 more times – 32½ 3 dc groups.

Border

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next hdc, 3 sc in ch-3 sp, [sc in hdc, sc in ch-1 sp, sc in hdc, 3 sc in ch-3 sp] to last hdc, sc in hdc, sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, working along side of piece, [2 sc in ch-2 sp, 3 sc in dc, 3 sc in ch-5 sp, sc in sc] to tip, sc in beg ch, turn – 298 sc along long edge of piece, 199 sc along top edge. (Ch-2 sp counts as 3 sc)

Row 2 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in next sc, [ch 4, sk next 2 sc, dc in next 2 dc, ch 4, sk next 3 sc] 2 times, dc in next 2 sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 4, dc in next 2 dc] 3 times, 3 dc in ch-4 sp, dc in last 2 dc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sl st in next 5 dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 4, dc in next 2 dc] 3 times, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 4, dc in next 2 dc] 2 times, 3 dc in ch-4 sp, dc in last 2 dc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sl st in next 5 dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 4, dc in next 2 dc] 2 times, turn.

Row 7: Ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 4, dc in next 2 dc, 3 dc in ch-4 sp, dc in last 2 dc, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, sl st in next 5 dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 4, dc in last 2 dc, turn.

Row 9: Ch 3, dc in next dc, 3 dc in ch-3 sps, dc in last 2 dc, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, sl st in next 6 dc, working along side of piece, work 3 sc in the side of each dc, sl st in next sc along Row 1 of Border.

Rep Rows 2-10, 14 more times – 15 reps along long edge of Shawl Body.

Rep Rows 2-10, 10 times along top (short) edge of Shawl Body.

Continuing along angled edge of Shawl Body, work 2 sc in the side of each hdc and 3 sc in the side of each dc; sc in beg sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends but do not trim. Pin out edges of Row 10 of each Border section. Wet or steam block. Trim ends when fully dry.
