Winter Rib Set

DIFFICULTY

Easy

HAT

SIZES

Child/Teen (Adult Small/Medium, Adult Large)

Shown in Adult Small/Medium Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 17¾ (20, 22¼)"

Height (with brim unfolded): 10¾ (11½, 13)"

COWL

SIZES

Small (Large)

Shown in Large size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 24 (34¼)"

Height: 10 (14)"

MITTS

SIZES

Adult Medium (Large)

Shown in Adult Medium size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 6½ (7½)"

Hand Circumference: 6¾ (8)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Deluxe Bulky Superwash (100% superwash wool; 100g/106yds)

- 332 Icy Grey (MC) – 4 balls
- 314 Petrol Blue (CC) – 1 ball

Needles: US Size 10 (6 mm) 16" and 24" circular and set of DPNS *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holder or waste yarn

GAUGE

18 sts x 18 rnds = 4" in K1, P1 Rib

PATTERN NOTES

Simple, soft, and squishy, the Winter Rib Set is your new go-to for keeping warm on the coldest winter days. Deluxe Bulky, comprised of 100% superwash wool, works up so quickly that you'll make this set in no time at all!

The hat, cowl, and mitts are knit in the round from the bottom up.

STITCH GUIDE

K1, P1 Rib

(multiple of 2 sts)

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

HAT

With 16" circ ndl and CC, cast on 80 (90, 100) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnds 1-2: Work in K1, P1 Rib to end.

Break CC, join MC.

With MC, cont as est'd in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas approx 7 (8, 9)" from cast-on edge.

Crown Shaping

Note: Change to DPNS when there are too few sts to fit comfortably on circ ndl.

Set-Up Rnd 1: * Cont as est'd over 16 (18, 20) sts, pm; rep from * to end – 5 markers placed across rnd.

Dec Rnd: * Cont as est'd to 2 sts bef m, k2tog; rep from * to end – 5 sts dec'd, 75 (85, 95) sts rem.



Rep Dec Rnd 13 (15, 17) more times – 65 (75, 85) sts dec'd, 10 sts rem.

Break yarn leaving approx 8" tail. Thread tail through rem live sts and pull taut to close.

COWL

Lower Hem

With 16 (24)" circ ndl and CC, cast on 108 (154) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnds 1-2: Work in K1, P1 Rib to end.

Break CC, join MC.

Main Body

With MC, cont as est'd in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 9½ (13½)" from cast-on edge. Break MC, join CC.

Upper Hem

Rnds 1-2: With CC, work in K1, P1 Rib to end.

Bind off all sts in pattern.

MITTS

(Make two)

With dpns and CC, cast on 30 (36) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnds 1-2: Work Rnd 1 of K1, P1 Rib to end.

Break CC, join MC.

With MC, cont as est'd in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 2½ (3)" from cast-on edge.

Shape for Thumb

Note: Maintain increased sts in K1, P1 Rib.

Set-Up Rnd: Cont as est'd in K1, P1 Rib over 26 (30) sts, pm, cont as est'd in K1, P1 Rib to end.

Inc Rnd: Cont as est'd in K1, P1 Rib to m, sl m, m1L, cont as est'd in K1, P1 Rib to bor m, m1R – 2 sts inc'd, 32 (38) sts.

Rep Inc Rnd every 2 rnds, 3 more times – 6 sts inc'd, 38 (44) sts.

Separate Thumb and Hand

Next Rnd: Cont as est'd to m, remove m, slip next 12 (14) Thumb sts to holder or waste yarn, cast on 2 sts, pm for new bor – 28 (32) sts rem for Hand.

Hand

Work even as est'd in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 6 (7)" from cast-on edge. Break MC, join CC.

Work 2 Rnds of K1, P1 Rib. Bind off all sts in patt.

Thumb

Return 12 (14) sts to ndl.

Rnd 1: Cont as est'd in K1, P1 Rib over 12 (14) sts, pick up and knit 2 sts along cast-on edge, pm to denote bor – 14 (16) sts. Cont as est'd in K1, P1 Rib until Thumb meas 1 (1½)" from picked-up edge. Bind off all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

bor	beginning of round
CC	contrast color
circ	circular
cont	continue
dec('d)	decrease(d)
dpn(s)	double pointed needle(s)
est'd	established
k	knit



k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m1L	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
m1R	insert left needle from back to front under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the front loop (1 st inc'd)
meas	measures
ndl	needle
p	purl
patt	pattern
rep	repeat
rnd	round
st(s)	stitch(es)
