



Free Crochet Pattern

Flamingo Scrubby Buddy

Lion Brand® Stitch Soak Scrub-24/7 Cotton®

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SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 7 in. (18 cm) high

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® STITCH SOAK SCRUB (Art. #781)
#142 Rose 1 ball (A)
- LION BRAND® 24/7 COTTON® (Art. #761)
#103 Pink Lemonade 1 ball (B)
#153 Black 1 ball (C)
#100 White 1 ball (D)
- Crochet hook size F-5 (3.75 mm)
- Crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Stitch markers
- Large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Fiberfill stuffing

Small amount of black yarn (for embroidering eyes)

GAUGE

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

STITCH EXPLANATION

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

1. Flamingo is made in 6 pieces: Loofah, Head, Beak, Flower, and 2 Feet.
2. Head and Beak are stuffed. Feet and Flower are not stuffed. Pieces are sewn to Loofah to make the Flamingo.
3. Exact gauge is not essential for this project. When working with 24/7 Cotton®, we worked tightly with a small hook so that stuffing does not show through spaces between stitches.

LOOFAH (Body)

With larger hook and A, ch 6; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 18 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

No marker is needed to indicate end of rnd. Just keep working around and around as instructed.

Next Rnds: Ch 1, (sc, 2 dc) in next st, 3 dc in each st around and just keep going around and around until almost all yarn has been used or Loofah is desired size, end with (2 dc, sc) in next st, sl st in next st.

Fasten off.

HEAD

With smaller hook and B, beg at top of head, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – you will have 12 sc in this rnd.

Rnd 3: * Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: * Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: * Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: * Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 7-15: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 16: * Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 17: * Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 18: * Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 19: * Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Stuff piece.

Rnds 20-22: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing Head to Loofah.

BEAK

With smaller hook and C, ch 2.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with sl st in first st – 3 sc.

Note: When working in joined rnds, work the first st of each rnd in the same st as the joining sl st.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first st.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first st – 6 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first st.

Fasten off.

Rnd 5: From RS with smaller hook, draw up a loop of D in same st as joining sl st, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next st, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts; join with sl st in first st – 8 sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first st.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in first 6 sts, sl st in next st; leave rem st unworked.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Stuff Beak.

FLOWER

With smaller hook and D, ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in ring; join with sl st in first st – 5 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, (dc, ch 1, sl st) in same st as joining sl st (first petal made), (sl st, ch 1, dc, ch 1, sl st) 4 times; join with sl st in base of beg ch-1 – 5 petals.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

FEET (make 2)

Ankle

With smaller hook and B, ch 6; join with sl st in first st.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, 8 sc in ring; join with sl st in first st – 8 sc.

Rnds 2-6: Ch 1, sc in each st round join with sl st in first st.

Top of Foot

Note: You will now begin working back and forth in rows.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in next 4 sts; leave rem 4 sts unworked for bottom of foot – 4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 6 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in last st – 8 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in last st – 10 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

Bottom of Foot

Row 1: From RS with smaller hook, draw up a loop of B in first unworked st following Row 1 of top of foot, ch 1, sc in same st and in next 3 unworked sts – 4 sc.

Rows 2-7: Work same as Rows 2-7 of top of foot.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail onto blunt needle and sew edges of top and bottom of foot together.

FINISHING

Following photo for placement, and using yarn tails for sewing, sew Beak to Head.

Thread a length of black yarn onto blunt needle and embroider eyes and eyelashes on Head

Sew Head to center of Loofah.

Sew Flower to top of Head.

Sew Feet to bottom of Flamingo.

Weave in ends.
