SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

About 36 x 36 in. (91.5 x 91.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Baby Soft® (Art. #920)
 - 136 Apricot 1 ball (A)
 - 107 Bluebell 1 ball (B)
 - 192 Orchid 1 ball (C)
 - 178 Teal 1 ball (D)
 - or colors of your choice
- Large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 6 (4 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm)

GAUGE

1 ripple = about 3 in. (7.5 cm) measured from peak to peak.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left hand needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right hand needle; insert left hand needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

1. Afghan is worked in one piece in an easy ripple pattern.
2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth in rows as if working with straight needles.
3. Yarn color is changed following a Stripe Sequence to make stripes.
4. To slip the first stitch of each row, you can slip as if to knit or slip as if to purl, whichever looks best with your knitting style.

AFGHAN

With A, cast on 246 sts.

Row 1: Sl 1, k2, *kfb, k7, ssk, k2tog, k7, kfb; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, p1 – you will have 12 ripples.

Row 2: Sl 1, k to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 changing color as in following Stripe Sequence: Work 4 more rows with A, 6 rows with B, 6 rows with C, 6 rows with D, 30 rows with A, 6 rows with B, 6 rows with C, 6 rows with D, 6 rows with A, 30 rows with B, 6 rows with

C, 6 rows with D, 6 rows with A, 6 rows with B, 30 rows with C, 6 rows with D, 6 rows with A, 6 rows with B, 6 rows with C, 30 rows with D, 6 rows with A, 6 rows with B, 6 rows with C, and 6 rows with D.
With D, bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

rep = repeat

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)
