





Itty Bitty Set

SIZES

Socks:

0-3 mo (2-3 yr, 4-5 yr) Shown in 0-3 mo size.

Hat

0-3 mo (2-3 yr, 4-5 yr) Show in 0-3 mo size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hat

Brim Circumference: 9¾ (11½, 13¼)" *Note: Hat is extremely stretchy.*

Socks

Foot Circumference: 4 (5, 6)"
Foot Length: Adjustable

Note: Socks are extremely stretchy.

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Bamboo Pop Sock (55% bamboo, 37% cotton, 8% pbt; 100g/492 yds)

408 Cherry Pie – 1 skein (all sizes)

Needles: US Size 1 (2.25 mm) set of dpns

or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Stitch marker, tapestry needle

GAUGE

32 sts x 40 rnds = 4" in St st 36 sts x 40 rnds = 4" in Sock or Hat Rib Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The Itty Bitty Set is perfect for the itty bitty ones in your life. Worked in Bamboo Pop Sock and featuring ribbing, both the hat and socks are extremely elastic and will stretch to fit as little ones grow.

The socks are knit from the cuff down. The hat is knit from the bottom to the crown.

I-Cord

* K4, slide sts to other end of ndl and place in left hand; rep from *.

STITCH GUIDE

Sock Rib

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: K1, p2, * k2, p2; rep from * to last st, k1. Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Hat Rib

(multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

SOCKS

Cast on 32 (40, 48) sts. Distribute sts evenly bet dpns, pm, and join to work in the rnd.

Cuff/Leg

Work Sock Rib until piece meas 3½ (4½, 5½)" from cast-on edge.

Heel Flap

Note: The Heel Flap is worked over first and last 8 (10, 12) sts of the rnd. The remaining 16 (20, 24) sts will form the Top of the Foot.

Row 1 (RS): K8 (10, 12), turn.

Row 2 (WS): P16 (20, 24), turn.

Row 3: [Sl 1, k1] 8 (10, 12) times, turn.

Row 4: Sl 1, p15 (19, 23).

Rows 5-18 (22, 26): Rep Rows 3 & 4, 7 (9, 11)

times.

Shape Heel with Short-Rows

Row 1 (RS): K9 (11, 13), ssk, k1, turn.

Row 2: Sl 1, p3, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 3: Sl 1, k4, ssk, k1, turn.

Row 4: Sl 1, p5, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 5: Sl 1, k6, ssk, k1, turn.

Row 6: Sl 1, p7, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 7: Sl 1, k8, ssk, k1, turn.

Row 8: Sl 1, p9, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 9: Sl 1, k9, ssk, k1, turn.

Row 10: Sl 1, p8, p2tog, p1, turn.

8 (10, 12) sts rem for Heel.

Gusset

Set-up Rnd: K4 (5, 6) Heel sts, pm to denote new bor, k4 (5, 6) Heel sts, pick up and knit 11 (13, 15) sts along side of Heel Flap, pm, work in est'd patt over 16 (20, 24) Instep sts, pm, pick up and knit 11 (13, 15) sts along the other side of Heel Flap, k4 (5, 6) (to beg of rnd) – 46 (56, 66) total sts; 30 (36, 42) Heel & Gusset sts; 16 (20, 24) Instep sts. **Dec Rnd:** Knit to 3 sts bef m, k2tog, k1, work as est'd to m, k1, ssk, knit to end – 2 sts dec'd – 44 (54, 66) sts rem.

Even Rnd: Knit to m, work as est'd to m, knit to end.

Rep these Dec Rnd and Even Rnd, 6 (7, 8) more times – 14 (16, 18) sts dec'd, 32 (40, 48) sts rem. Work even as est'd until Foot meas 2 (3, 4)", or 1 $(1\frac{1}{4}, 1\frac{1}{2})$ " less than desired length.

Shape Toe

Dec rnd: Knit to 3 sts bef m, k2tog, k1, sl m, k1, ssk, knit to 3 sts bef m, k2tog, k1, sl m, k1, ssk, knit to end – 4 sts dec'd, 28 (36, 44) sts rem.

Even rnd: Knit.

Rep these 2 rnds, 4 (5, 6) more times -12 (16, 20) sts rem. Place 6 (8, 10) Heel sts on one ndl and 6 (8, 10) Instep sts on separate ndl, holding them parallel to one another. Graft the two sets of sts tog using Kitchener st.

FINISHING

Block to finished measurements and weave in ends. Fold down cuff to wear.

HAT

Cast on 88 (104, 120) sts. Distribute sts evenly bet dpns and join to work in the rnd. Work in Hat Rib until piece meas $4\frac{1}{2}$ (5, 6)".

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: * K2, p2, k2tog, p2; rep from * to end – 11 (13, 15) sts dec'd, 77 (91, 105) sts rem.

Rnd 2: * K2, p2, k1, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: * K2, p2tog, k1, p2; rep from * to end – 11

(13, 15) sts dec'd, 66 (78, 90) sts rem.

Rnd 4: * K2, p1, k1, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: * K2tog, p1, k1, p2; rep from * to end – 11

(13, 15) sts dec'd, 55 (65, 75) sts rem.

Rnd 6: * K1, p1, k1, p2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: * K1, p1, k1, p2tog; rep from * to end – 11

(13, 15) sts dec'd, 44 (52, 60) sts rem.

Rnd 8: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: * K2tog; rep from * to end – 22 (26, 30)

sts rem.

Rnd 10: * K2tog; rep from * to end – 11 (13, 15)

sts rem.

Baby only

Rnd 11: [K3tog] 3 times, k2tog – 4 sts rem.

Toddler only

Rnd 11: [K3tog] 4 times, k1 – 5 sts rem.

Rnd 12: K2tog, knit to end of round. – 4 sts rem.

Child only

Rnd 11: [K3tog] 5 times – 5 sts rem.

Rnd 12: K2tog, knit to end of round. – 4 sts rem.

All Sizes

Work in I-Cord over rem 4 sts for 4". Bind off rem

4 sts. Tie I-Cord in a knot.

FINISHING

Block to finished measurements and weave in ends. If desired, fold brim upward to wear.
