Set Of Four (Or More!) Bibs

FREE KNITTING PATTERN

M23028 BSAM

SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZE

About 8 x 8 1/2 in. (20.5 x 21.5 cm), not including straps

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-MICROBIAL (Art. #204)
 - #099 Vintage 1 ball (A)
 - #124 Hazelwood 1 ball (B)
 - #149 Cement 1 ball (C)
 - #152 Charcoal 1 ball (D)
- LION BRAND® knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch holder
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

18 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then knit through back of same st – 1 st increased.

NOTES

1. Each Bib is worked in one piece in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with Garter st (k every st of every row) borders and straps.
2. Bib is worked from the lower edge upwards. At neck, piece is divided for straps and front neck.

Zero Waste Crafting!

If you make the set of Bibs, you won't use all of the yarn. We encourage you to be creative and make another Bib or two with the leftover yarn!

Just use our pattern and add your own design of stripes or blocks of color. If you still have yarn remaining, use a simple straight stitch to embroider words or pictures onto any of the Bibs, or embroider cross stitches inside the borders.

BIB

With yarn color of your choice, cast on 27 sts.

Lower Border

Row 1 (WS): K1, kfb, k to end of row – you will have 28 sts in this row.

Rows 2-10: Rep Row 1 for 9 more times, until there are 37 sts.

Bib

Row 1 (WS): K5 (for side border), p to last 5 sts, k5 (for side border).

Row 2: Knit.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 7 1/2 in. (19 cm) from beginning, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Work in Garter st (k every st of every row) for 6 rows.

Divide for Straps

Next Row (RS): K11 and place these sts on a holder for 2nd strap, bind off next 15 sts for front neck, k11 for first strap.

First Strap

Work on 11 first strap sts only.

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2: K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 9 sts.

Rows 3-6: Rep Rows 1 and 2 twice more, until only 5 sts remain.

Work in Garter st until strap measures about 7 in. (18 cm) from divide.

Bind off.

Note: Straps are meant to be loosely tied around baby's neck – just work to desired length!

Second Strap

Return 11 second strap sts to needle so that you are ready to work a WS row.

Join yarn and work same as first strap.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
