

## Succulent Scarf

## SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
Width: 103/4"
Length (excluding fringe): 74"

## MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Classic Shades (70\% acrylic, 30\% wool; 100g/197 yds)

- 735 Smoky Denim (A) - 2 skeins
- 747 Spring (B) - 2 skeins

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) or size
needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE
15 sts x 9 rows $=4$ " in Scarf patt Save time, check your gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

Simple and soothing, the Succulent Scarf is the perfect project for celebrating the autumn season. We've chosen a duo of botanicallyinspired colors for this design, but with a wide array of self-shading colors in the Classic Shades palette, we can't wait to see what colors you choose!

This scarf is worked flat in one piece. The pattern is both written and charted for your convenience. Cut yarn after each color change. To save time in finishing, weave in the ends as you go. At the end of each wrong-side row, finish the last step of each stitch with the next color.

## STITCH GUIDE

Spike Dc: Yo, insert hk into indicated st from front to back, yo, pull up lp even with work (3 lps on hk), yo, and proceed with double crochet.

## SCARF

With A, ch 281.
Set-up Row 1 (RS): With A, dc in fourth ch from hk, * [dc in next ch] 2 times, ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * to last 2 chs, dc in each of last 2 chs, turn.
Set-up Row 2 (WS): With A, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in next dc, * dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, [dc in next dc] 2 times; rep from * to end of row, ending with dc on top of turning ch, change to $B$, turn.
Row 1: With B, ch 3, * ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, Spike Dc in next ch-1 sp 2 rows below, dc in next st; rep from * to last 2 dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc on top of turning ch, turn.
Row 2: With B, ch 4 (counts as dc and ch-1 sp here and throughout), * [dc in next dc] 3 times, ch 1, sk next dc; rep from * to last dc, dc on top of turning ch, change to $A$, turn.
Row 3: With A, ch 3, * Spike Dc in next ch-1 sp 2 rows below, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * to last ch-1 sp of row, Spike Dc in last ch-1 sp 2 rows below, dc on top of turning ch, turn.
Row 4: With A, ch 4, dc in next dc, * dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, [dc in next dc] 2 times; rep from


* to end of row ending with dc on top of turning ch, turn.
Rows 5-24: Rep Rows 1-4, 5 more times. Fasten off.


## FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

## Fringe

Cut 112, 12" pieces of B. For each group of fringe, hold 4 strands together. Attach 14 groups evenly spaced to each end of scarf. Trim fringe to 5 ".
