DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

Toddler (Child, Adult Small, Adult Medium, Adult Large)

Shown in Adult Medium size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Brim Circumference (unstretched): 14 (16, 18, 20, 22)"

Stretches to approx.: 15½ (17½, 19½, 21½, 23½)"

Height (with brim unfolded): 9½ (10¼, 10½, 11¼, 11½)"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Posh Alpaca* (45% wool, 30% acrylic, 25% superfine alpaca; 100g/98 yds)

Two-Color Version

- 110 Admiral (MC) – 1 ball (all sizes)
- 102 Oak (CC1) – 1 ball (all sizes)

Three-Color Version

- 101 Birch (MC) – 1 ball (all sizes)
- 102 Oak (CC1) – 1 ball (all sizes)
- 108 Velveteen (CC2) – 1 ball (all sizes)

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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Needles: US Size 11 (8 mm) 16" circular and set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) *or size needed to obtain gauge*
US Size 10.5 (6.5 mm) 16" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, 2 (2½, 3½, 4, 4)" pom pom maker

GAUGE

12 sts x 16 rnds = 4" Stockinette stitch (St st)
using larger ndl

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Cold weather, meet your new bestie! The Ozbelli hat is a simple, yet super stylish accessory that's perfect to throw on to keep your head toasty warm. Posh Alpaca's blend of wool, acrylic, and alpaca makes for a luxurious look and feel, enhanced by the chic color blocking on the hat. This roving style yarn works up so fast, making the Ozbelli hat perfect for gifting!

This hat is knit in the round from the bottom up. The brim is worked in a stretchy, K1, P1 Rib. The body of the hat is worked in Stockinette stitch. Finally, a pom pom is made using color C and attached to the top of the hat.

Please note that the Toddler, and Child sizes require double-pointed needles or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences throughout the pattern. The Adult Small, Medium, and Large sizes will begin with 16" circular needles and switch to needles appropriate for small circumferences during the crown shaping, when stitches no longer fit comfortably on the circular needle.

PATTERN BEGINS

Brim

With CC1 and smaller ndl, cast on 42 (48, 54, 60, 66) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 until piece meas 4 (4½, 4¾, 5, 5)" from cast-on edge.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Break CC1. Join color MC. Change to larger ndl.

Hat Body

Rnd 1: With MC, knit.

Rep Rnd 1 until piece meas approx. 6¾ (7, 7, 7¼, 7½)" from cast-on edge.

Shape Crown

Note: Please change to DPNs or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences when there are too few stitches to fit comfortably on circular needle.

Set-up Rnd: * K7 (8, 9, 10, 11), pm; rep from * to end.

Dec Rnd: * Knit to 2 sts bef m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end – 6 sts dec'd. 36 (42, 48, 54, 60) sts rem.

Even Rnd: Knit.

Rep Dec Rnd and Even Rnd 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) more times – 24 (30, 36, 42, 48) sts dec'd, 12 sts rem (all sizes).

Next Rnd: * Ssk; rep from * to end – 6 sts dec'd, 6 sts rem.

Break yarn leaving approx. 8" tail. Using a tapestry ndl, thread tail through rem live sts and pull taut to close.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

Pom Pom

Two-Color Version

With color CC1, make a 2 (2½, 3½, 4, 4)" pom pom using pom pom maker, making sure to leave a tail of approx. 6". We recommend securing the pom pom with a 4-ply, thinner yarn in a similar color as Posh Alpaca is a lightly spun single-ply yarn and may not be as secure for attaching the pom pom. Secure pom pom to top of hat, weaving the tail into the inside of the work.

Three-Color Version

With color CC2, make a 2 (2½, 3½, 4, 4)" pom pom using pom pom maker, making sure to leave a tail of approx. 6". We recommend securing the pom pom with a 4-ply, thinner yarn in a similar color as Posh Alpaca is a lightly spun single-ply yarn and may not be as secure for attaching the pom pom. Secure pom pom to top of hat, weaving the tail into the inside of the work.

st(s)	stitch(es)



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
